Core Benefits

Other Available Benefits and Coverages

- Security and Natural Disaster Evacuation: Covers the transportation and related costs to relocate insured persons in the event of civil or political unrest, terrorism, or natural disasters
- War Risk: Provides coverage for losses due to acts of war
- Trip Cancellation: Reimbursement for prepaid, non-refundable expenses incurred if trip must be canceled due to unforeseen circumstances
- Lost Baggage: Helps to replace essential items, clothing, and personal belongings when baggage is unable to be recovered

Claim Scenarios Scenario 1:

A private school is sponsoring a 2-week educational trip to Europe for students, teachers, and chaperones. On the second day of the trip, one of the students became ill and was taken to a hospital via ambulance and confined there for several days, unable to continue the trip with the group. The policy will respond by coordinating the medical emergency evacuation, providing guarantee of payment to the hospital, and facilitating the payments directly to the local providers, without the student incurring out of pocket expenses. The policy also will cover the expenses to bring the ill student's father to their bedside, including the lodging and food expenses during the five days of hospital confinement. Lastly, the policy will cover the expenses to return both individuals back to their home and partially refund the unused, non-refundable tour expenses of the student.

Scenario 2:

A religious organization is sponsoring a mission trip to Asia. During the trip, the region is struck by a major earthquake. The policy will respond by coordinating a natural disaster evacuation for the entire group, safely returning the group back to the United States on a privately chartered aircraft at no cost to the group.
