

**CHOICE TO EXCLUDE HOUSEHOLD RESIDENT(S) FROM COVERAGE OF
MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY
(Utah)**

The Law

The Utah Insurance Code (Section 31A-22-303(7)) permits you, the insured named in the policy, to exclude from coverage of your motor vehicle liability insurance a person(s) who is (are) a resident(s) of your household, including person(s) who usually make his/her (their) home in your same household but temporarily live elsewhere. To exclude such person(s) from your coverage the following two requirements must be met:

- (1) Each person excluded must have his/her own owner's or operator's security at the time of this proposed exclusion; and
- (2) You and the person(s) excluded from coverage must each provide written consent to the exclusion.

Choice to Exclude Coverage

If you choose to exclude coverage from any person(s) please fill out this form and RETURN it to your insurance agent or company. Any and all persons whose names are filled-in below MUST SIGN this form to provide the needed written consent for the desired exclusion.
