REJECTION OF MEDICAL PAYMENTS COVERAGE (Colorado)

Colorado law permits you, the insured named in the policy, to reject Medical Payments Coverage. Medical Payments Coverage pays for reasonable health care expenses incurred for bodily injury sustained by an insured and caused by an automobile accident regardless of fault.

Medical payments coverage is primary to any health insurance coverage available to an insured when injured in an automobile accident. This coverage applies to any coinsurance or deductible amount required to be paid by the person's health coverage plan as defined in § 10-16-102(22.5), C.R.S.

An insured who is injured in an automobile accident will not receive benefits from medical payments coverage for any medical expenses incurred as a result of an accident that is the fault of the insured unless medical payments coverage is purchased.

I understand that unless rejected, Medical Payments Coverage will be included in my policy.
